Our Resident Services and Resident Opportunity & Self Sufficiency Program are created to assist families by providing community resources that will address and meet the needs of the whole family.

However, it is the responsibility of each family to do what it takes to meet the need of their family. Week after week the THA resident services and ROSS programs provide valuable resources through, workshops, seminars and classes in the community (on site). This is made possible to remove the barrier of needing transportation to receive the resource. It is up to each of you to attend. Please be reminded that it is a part of your lease that you will attend programs offered by the authority. **COMMUNITY SERVICE PARTICIPANTS, you do not have much choice. If you are delinquent with your CS hours, you SHOULD attend all sessions and trainings that are offered by the authority to acquire your 8 hours of community service. It is MANDATORY that you perform 8 hrs of community service per month.** Your community services hours are monitored monthly. If you are in violation, you will be notified.,

Attending the classes and trainings offered by the THA is an easy way to meet your CS requirement and gain valuable knowledge. So, take advantage of these opportunities and move your family forward toward SELF-SUFFICIENCY!
